Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 9 – KS4 Subject Options

As-salaamu-alaikum (peace be with you). Subject option choices mark an exciting point in your daughter's journey at Feversham Academy when you and your daughter make decisions about some of the subjects she will be studying during Key Stage 4. We want our students to be ambitious about their success and to be prepared for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of adult life and to overcome any barriers to learning that they may have.

The KS4 Options process will begin in GST on Thursday 21st January via an assembly through MS Teams. Your daughter will receive advice and guidance to support her to make informed choices about what subjects to choose. She will receive a link to join the assembly through her email. Please encourage her to attend as valuable information will be shared about the whole process.

The options booklet is also available on the school website and has been emailed to your daughter. Please take the time to go through the information provided in the options booklet.

All students will study the following core subjects: English Language, English Literature, Mathematics, Science, Religious Studies, History OR Geography, MFL, PE and Citizenship. In addition to this there will be a number of options subjects to choose from: Art & Design, Textile Design, Creative iMedia, Health and Social Care, Sports Science, Hospitality & Catering and Triple Science.

All subjects will result in either a GCSE or Vocational Award, both of which lead to post 16 Education, employment or training. We also ask that you choose a **reserve** subject in case we are unable to offer one of the choices made.

We appreciate that you will want to talk about this with your daughter to ensure that you help her make the right decision insha'Allah. To complement this, we will provide in school careers advice during tutorial time, dedicated assemblies and support from subject tutors. Ultimately we want to work together to ensure that your daughter is a successful learner who has the skills and opportunities to enjoy, learn and succeed.

Please take this opportunity to discuss the various options subjects with your daughter so that she is confident in the choices she is making. Once she has decided on her final options she will need to complete the online form which will be available from 25 January. **It is important that she completes the form by 5 February 2021** and submits the form so it is sent into school.
