Dear Parent/Carer,

Salaam-Alaikum/Peace be with you,

Given the unprecedented situation regarding Covid-19, I wanted to outline to you how we have planned for pupils to work remotely during the enforced school closure.

All teachers have set work and uploaded resources onto a shared platform - Sharepoint. This link is now available on the school website under 'Connect Links'. Each pupil will receive an email which will outline how they can access Sharepoint which contains their work. Pupils who use Microsoft Teams in some subjects will be able to access the work for those subjects through Teams. Every pupil should have their log in details and will be able to access this work from home via the internet.

Teachers have uploaded work already to ensure our pupils can immediately continue their learning outside of the classroom. There will be a range of activities to help encourage pupils to engage in their lessons remotely: revision booklets, individual lessons, mini projects and website links to promote interactive learning. We appreciate that there will need to be some degree of flexibility in learning remotely that also works best for your child and family in the home.

Subject teachers will be available via email throughout the teaching day to support and will endeavour to respond swiftly to pupils' questions and queries. As well as this, staff from Pastoral teams will also be available to contact via email.

Department email contact details will be on our website under the 'Contact Us' page, which will help to support your child in accessing the work if there are any issues. We appreciate the support of parents and carers in ensuring that our pupils are keeping up with work at home as best they can. You can support them and the school in the following ways:

- Provide an appropriate place to work at home with internet and computer access. Please ensure you have set parental controls on your internet. Please speak to your service provider for more information.
- Check that your child can successfully log onto the shared platform and other online applications used to support learning (for example BBC Bitesize).
- Ensure your child has the necessary equipment, such as their pencil case, writing paper/exercise books, text books and revision guides as appropriate
- Help plan and structure the school work that your child has been set and offer to help if he/she is finding a piece of work challenging.

Details of how parents/carers and pupils can contact the academy and teachers during any closure period will be on our website. The website will be regularly updated with information and work as required. If you use Twitter you can also find updates and information on @FevershamA.

It is important that we work together to support your child over the next few weeks, so please do not hesitate to contact the academy if you need any further information.
