### **Remote Learning Update**

Firstly I would like to thank you all for your ongoing support during these unprecedented times. I appreciate that this has been a challenging time for all, and hope that pupils have had the support needed to help them adjust to the demands that the lockdown has enforced upon all of us.

As you will be aware, the current government guidelines means that school will remain closed for students in Years 7-9 of secondary schools. This means that for these students, remote learning will be the only type of learning that they will have access to until the end of this current term. With this in mind, I would just like to summarise some of the ways we are providing remote learning and to highlight some of the ways you can continue to support your daughter, and signpost again, where you can direct any questions or queries.

### **Yr 7-9 Remote Learning**

- Students should be accessing work through Sharepoint on the website and/or Teams as directed by each subject area. Students who do not have access to electronic devices can have workbooks printed by school and these can be collected from school/posted (you must get in touch with school and arrange a pick up time/date if appropriate). Once the workbooks have been completed, they can be returned to school so that teachers can provide feedback to students.
- Each subject area will invite students to attend online Teams sessions where a teacher will be available to answer questions, help with work that has been set or give feedback on previous work that has been completed – this may be up to once week for each subject so there will be several sessions that she is invited to in any given week. Students should know how to access these sessions but if further help is needed, students should email their SSO who will be able to direct their queries to the appropriate person. If your daughter is unable to access these sessions then she can email teachers and ask someone to contact her via phone if she requires support with any work.
- Form tutors are making welfare telephone calls on a fortnightly basis. It is important that your daughter engages with these calls, and lets her form tutor know if there are any issues that the school can support her with. If you have changed your phone number recently, please email school with an up to date telephone number. We also use your phone number to send out reminders and links to documents on the website so it is important that we have the right details.
- If you wish to contact any subject area about your daughter's learning, contact details can be found on the website. Alternatively, your daughter can send an email to any of her teachers using her school account.

Thank you very much for supporting us in all that you are doing by ensuring that your daughter has a productive learning environment at home where she can engage in the learning. If you feel we can support in any further way, then do not hesitate to get in touch.
